

1. Name and contacts of Data Controller

SECTRAN Kft. [SECTRAN Limited Liability Company, (company registry number: 16-09-016061, EU VAT number: HU 14313965; Head office: H-1033 Budapest, Szentendrei út 89-93; phone number: +36 1 784-6830, represented by Tímea Garai/managing director), hereinafter referred to as "SECTRAN"]

2. Subject of data control

Driver Intelligence Database (DiDb)

3. Data subjects

Data subjects are drivers applying for or possessing DiDb membership.

4. The purpose of data control

The operation of the DiDb system; the registration and recording of the data of concerned data subjects.

5. Legal basis of data control and provision of preliminary information

SECTRAN informs the data subjects before starting the data processing procedure by the present form and the effective "Manual of Data Control in DiDb system" (hereinafter referred to as "Manual") which constitutes an inseparable part of present form. The effective "Manual" is available at all DiDb registration offices and on www.didb.eu. In order to fulfil the purposes of data controlling, SECTRAN is entitled to control data only with specific legal basis, which is defined in Chapter 7 of the Manual. Data subject initiates the control of his/her personal data by registering into DiDb system. All data are provided directly by the data subject - excluded the data relating to the transport assignments carried out by the data subject, and those data that are connected to extraordinary events happened during the transport fulfilment, therefore they may be linked to the data subject and become personal data. SECTRAN controls personal data exclusively for the purpose determined in the course of data recording in order to apply rights and fulfil obligations. Personal data may only be controlled to a minimum extent and for the duration of time required for this purpose. The personal use of personal data is prohibited therefore SECTRAN does not use them for personal purposes. Data shall not be transmitted to a third party by SECTRAN, excluding transmission of data required by the authority for the purpose of investigating mandatory, statutory, documented and infringing acts.

6. Categories of controlled data and methods of data recording

The categories of controlled data are: data for identification; contact data; financial data; data for verification of professional competence for the fulfilment of transport assignment; data for verification of authorized eligibility for the fulfilment of transport assignment; data of Certificate of Good Conduct; in case of dual citizenship: Naturalization Certificate; data connected to the fulfilment of transport assignment; data connected to extraordinary event during the fulfilment of transport assignment; data connected to DiDb membership. The data is collected, registered and stored both on paper basis and electronically. More detailed process description of the above is included in the Manual.

7. Data processing

SECTRAN is entitled to involve data processor in the data processing activities based on the applicable law. SECTRAN provides information to the data subjects about the data processors in the "Manual". The data processor is entitled to make queries, records or modification on the data categories defined in Point 6, depending on its legal relationship with the data controller. More detailed process description of the above is included in the Manual.

8. Term of data control, deadline for deletion of data

Data control shall be affected during the existence of the contractual legal relation between data subject and SECTRAN, or until the data subject's request for data deletion is fulfilled. The data shall be deleted by SECTRAN within the shortest possible time in case the purpose of the data control is ceased (deletion of DiDb membership from the system) or any information is provided to SECTRAN that the data control is unlawful. Deletion of membership from the DiDb system entails the obligation of returning the DiDb card to SECTRAN. Data Controller shall delete all data of the data subject from the system with final effect. Deleted driver may not be registered again in the system.

9. Data security measures

The employees of SECTRAN's organizational units performing data control, and the employees of organizations taking part in data control on behalf of SECTRAN, must keep all personal data disclosed to them as business secret, and must sign a Confidentiality Agreement. In addition, SECTRAN – in accordance with the contents of the "Manual"– ensures the security of the controlled data, by taking the necessary technical and organizational measures, as well as applying procedural rules that are required to be enforced in compliance with related regulations.

10. Rights of data subject regarding data control of its personal data. Enforcement of rights and options for legal remedies

On the mailing address of SECTRAN defined in point 1, the data subject may request to conduct a proceeding on the enforcement of his/her rights based on stipulations of chapter 6 of the Manual. All the options for legal remedies – filing a complaint to the supervisory authority or to the competent court - are also defined in chapter 6 of the Manual.
