

MEMBERSHIP CONTINUANCE DECLARATION

hereby declare my intention to maintain my membership in the Driver Intelligence Database (hereinafter referred to as DiDb) whose exclusive data controller is **SECTRAN Kft.** (company registry number: 16-09-016061, EU VAT number: HU 14313965, head office: H-1033, Budapest, Szentendrei út 89-93, hereinafter referred to as SECTRAN), with the conditions as follows:

1. I declare that I have read and understood the content of the "DiDb System-User's Manual", which constitutes an inseparable part of the present declaration and also published on www.didb.eu. I acknowledge that during the membership validation procedure my attention was called to the content of the above document and the terms contained therein are binding upon me.
2. By signing the present Declaration I declare that the application form of "Information on data control" (which covers particularly but not exclusively my rights in association with the data controlling procedures carried on my personal data as well as my rights for legal remedies) and the "Manual of data control in the DiDb system" (hereinafter referred to as Manual) have been provided for me, moreover I have understood the content of these documents and I consent to the control of my personal data as per described therein. I declare that my consent to the membership validation is based on my voluntary and informed decision. The purpose of controlling my personal data is to maintain my membership in DiDb system. I have understood that my request for terminating the data control on my data – depending on the type of the data controlled – can also mean the termination of the contractual relationship described herein.
3. I acknowledge that based on existing legislation and according to the documents and regulations referred to in point 2, SECTRAN may involve data processor(s) in its activity connected to the maintenance of my DiDb membership. SECTRAN provides information on the data processors in the Manual and by other communication channels, but I can request information about the data processor(s) involved in data processing anytime.
4. I acknowledge that SECTRAN, as the data controller and operator of the DiDb system is not liable for the possible impacts of its decision – such as refusal of membership validation application, qualification, suspension, exclusion - on my employment contract.
5. Furthermore, I declare that the stipulations of "Incident Management Rules of the DiDb system" published on the www.didb.eu website are binding to me during the entire duration of my membership.
6. I undertake that the DiDb membership validation service, in accordance with the type of service used and the service fees published on the website www.didb.eu , will be paid in cash or in case of previous agreement subsequently by wire transfer - and I acknowledge that this obligation shall be applied even if the application for membership validation is rejected.
7. Being aware of my criminal responsibility I declare that
 - as far as I know, no prosecution or infringement proceedings are being conducted against me
 - I am not banned from practicing public affairs
 - I am a legally natural person
 - the personal data provided by me during the membership validation process are true
 - all of my documents submitted are original and genuine
8. I understood that the contract between me and SECTRAN regarding the maintenance of my DiDb membership is accepted and entered by SECTRAN by its approval of present declaration. All issues relevant to this declaration and to the contract takes effect after the acceptance of this declaration shall be settled by the application of the Hungarian laws on civil rights and data protection legislation in force, in particular the Act V. of 2013 on the Hungarian Civil Code and the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and in observation of the repeal of the Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation / GDPR). The parties hereby submit that the Hungarian Court of competent jurisdiction is entitled to settle any dispute.
